

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

eRedbook Data Flows with Providers/Clinicians

Data Flow	Description
Initiation	Receives a message from the sender system with demographics details about the parent and child to enable parents to be automatically invited to sign up for eRedbook.
Subscription	Once a parent has signed up and their NHS Number confirmed (authorised) eRedbook send a message to relevant systems to tell them to start to send data to the eRedbook.
Appointments	Enables the receipt of appointment information in to eRedbook
Immunisations	Enables the receipt of immunisation information in to eRedbook
Hearing Screening	Enables the receipt of hearing screening results information in to eRedbook
Bloodspot Screening	Enables the receipt of bloodspot results information in to eRedbook
New baby review	Enables the receipt of review information in to eRedbook
Health reviews	Enables the receipt of review information in to eRedbook
6-8 week review	Enables the receipt of review information in to eRedbook
Demographics	Enables eRedbook to notify recipient systems when mum updates her email, mobile or address details.
New-born Examination (NIPE)	Enables the receipt of NIPE results information in to eRedbook

TYLER

Tyler is 6 and has brittle asthma and ADHD. He has attended A&E 6 times in the last 9 months, being admitted on 3 of those occasions. with a single night on ITU for one of them

Mo is in his 50's. He is an alcoholic. In the last 12 months Mo has attended A&E 23 times; sometimes at the Royal, sometimes at Aintree and occasionally at Whiston.

Terry has known Mo since they were kids; they both love heavy metal music. Mike, a Health Trainer is supporting both of them to access local community groups and services.

BETTY

Betty is in her 70's and suffers from early dementia. Having met social care eligibility criteria she receives some community care. As her mental state worsens she is afraid of being put into a home.

Betty fostered Mo when he was a child, but they haven't spoken in a long time. Betty eventually gave up on Mo, having tried everything to help him off the drink.

LAYLA

Layla is in her 20's and lives with Tyler. She has battled with depression for most of her young life and suffers with severe anxiety issues and Crohns disease

Layla is Terry's daughter and from time to time she will visit her Mumwho cares for her Dad. Sometimes Layla has to help her Mum lift Terry into the bath.

OUR TERRY

Terry is 59. He has Diabetes, COPD and a 90% risk of unplanned admission to hospital in the next 12 months

> Terry was never that close to Mei, but now he's also unable to get out and see her much.

AUNTY

Mei is in her 90's. A couple of years ago she suffered from a fall and fractured her hip. She is now being looked after in a care home.

RILEY

Riley is 17. Riley has severe cerebral palsy following neonatal meningitis, epilepsy and recurrent chest infections



Riley is Terry's grandson by his older son Wayne. Wayne is Riley's full time carer.



Authoritative Body for Information Governance




Independent Information Governance Oversight Panel

The Independent Information Governance Oversight Panel (IIGOP) was established at the request of the Secretary of State to advise, challenge and report on the state of information governance across the health and care system in England. It is non-statutory, independent committee and will work in an advisory capacity. IIGOP will work with bodies such as the Health and Social Care Information Centre and NHS England to implement recommendations from the Dame Fiona Caldicott review: 'Information: to share or not to share'.






Information Governance Approach








Use case: Patient referral for self-care using apps/devices
