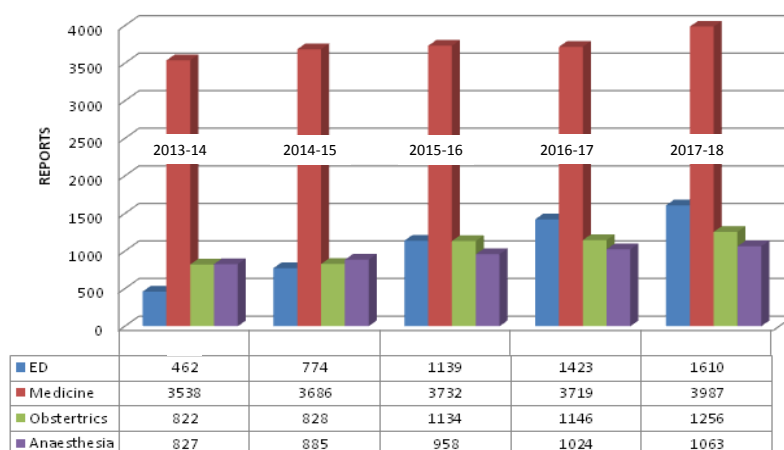

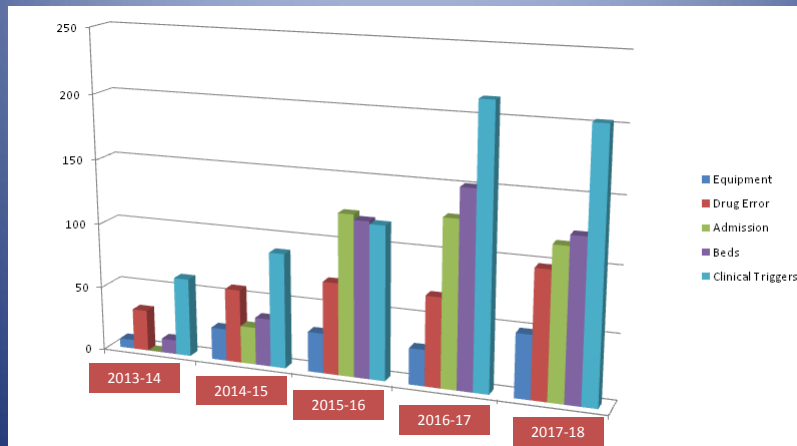

STOP before you block



**To all clinicians in the ED placing
a Fascia Iliac Block:**

- A STOP moment must take place immediately before inserting the block needle

**Factors Contributing to
Wrong Sided Blocks**

Distraction in
the ED

Delay between
WHO* & block

Social activity
in the ED

Human Error

*WHO = World Health Organisation Checklist

Check the side

Mark the side

Confirm with the
Patient or nurse

Have the x-ray open

Safety Checklist for: Fascia Iliac Block

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SIGN IN (To be read out loud)

Before procedure

Bupivacaine dosing:

Max dose = 2mg/kg

0.25% Bupiv = 2.5mg/ml so 10mls = 25mg

Standard 30ml of 0.25% WILL be too much for patients <40kg

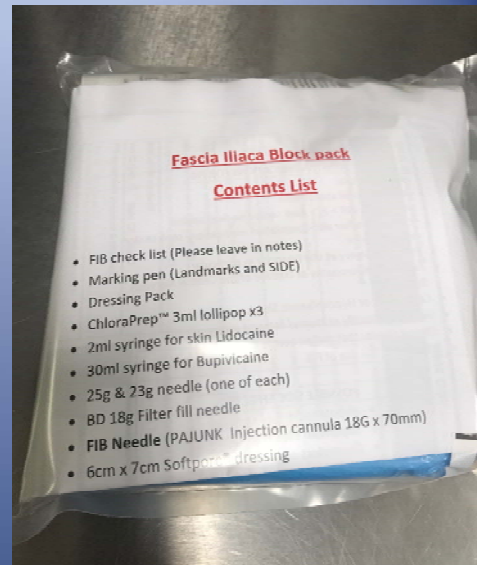
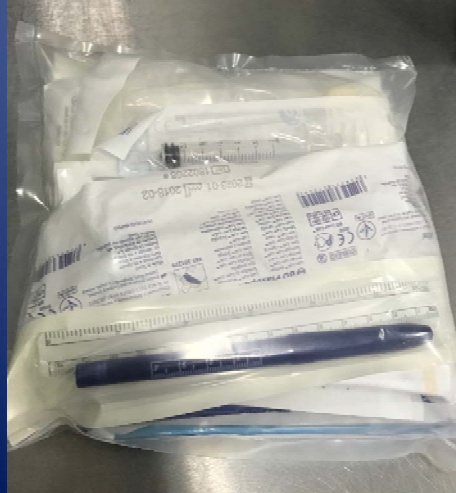
